

TOPIC:
**Through-and-Through
Needling Technique**

Through-and-through needling is an ancient, highly regarded needling technique. It is described in the Nei Jing classic text (Yu Long Ge portion). This way of needling requires horizontal or perpendicular needling from one acu-point into another, accomplishing the purpose of needling two or more acu-points with one needle. Use of fewer needles means reduced needling pain. But most importantly, therapeutic effect is amplified with this method.
